The PASS Foundation has designated June 25-29 as "PASS Awareness Week", with a special "PASS Awareness Day" on June 29th.

PASS is an acronym for Post Abortion Stress Syndrome, and is a name for a collection of problems that can affect some women after an abortion.

PASS Awareness Week also marks the third anniversary of the PASS Online Support Site, <http://www.afterabortion.com>

The PASS support site has been helping women, men and family members affected by abortion since June 1998. The site provides help through non-political, non-religious "peer support" discussion, volunteer helpers, online recovery groups and various resources and information. The site's numerous and busy message boards provide specialized support for many different post-abortion situations, as well as common recovery issues.

The PASS Foundation is a politically neutral, non-religion affiliated organization that seeks to have PASS treated as a medical issue for women, not as a political or religious one.
